Place Restrictions

- Utah Law – not in public buildings, parks or stadiums
 - Tailgating
 - Exception—A proprietary use (rental)
- University Guidelines
 - Certain designated buildings
 - Others as approved by cognizant VP



Designated Buildings-OGC Website

- Utah Museum of Natural History (Sr. VP for Acad. Affairs)
- Utah Museum of Fine Arts (Sr. VP for Acad. Affairs)
- Alumni House (VP for Univ. Relations)
- Stadium Tower (but not the stadium itself) (VP for Admin. Services)
- Orangerie and Visitors Center at Red Butte Garden (VP for Univ. Relations)
- Officer's Club (VP for Student Affairs)
- Commander's House (VP for Student Affairs)
- University Guest House (including affiliated facilities) (VP for Student Affairs)
- The Pointe (Sr. VP for Health Sciences)
- Salt Lake 2002 Visitors Center (VP for Admin. Services)
- Huntsman Center Lounge (VP for Admin. Services)
- Kingsbury Hall (Sr. VP for Acad. Affairs)



Hosting Restrictions

- No alcohol may be served in University buildings at events hosted by University entities or departments
- Events with alcohol must be hosted by a third party
 - Pursuant to agreement with 3rd party

Attendance Restrictions

- Events must only be open to invited guests
 - Not open to general public
- Most attendees must be non-University persons
 - Must be 50%+ non-University attendees
 - Development exception
- Minor students must not be invited attendees
 - Exception for family/friends at private event



Sales Restrictions

- No sales of alcohol on campus
 - No Cash bars
 - Exception: Private party event and DABC special permit
 - No tickets that include price of alcohol
 - If tickets, then separate funding for alcohol-**NEVER STATE FUNDS**
 - Drink tickets ok--for rationing only



Approval process

- Senior VP responsible for building must approve
 - Complete approval form-(OGC Website)
- Complete rental agreement with 3rd party sponsoring event
 - University guidelines
 - Licensed/bonded bar tender
 - Comply with liquor laws
 - University indemnification



Hypotheticals

1. Ballet Department Christmas party at Museum of Fine Arts.
 - Can't do it-More than 50% University employees
2. College of Science Donor Event at Rice Eccles
 - Can do it-3rd party sponsor, catered, no general public, no minor students, request for alcohol, contract with sponsor, no State funds for alcohol

Hypotheticals (cont.)

3. Wedding in Red Butte Orangerie
 - Can do it: Contract with private party & alcohol addendum, University authorized caterer, no cash bar, no general public



Other Legal Issues



Minors on Campus

- New University Policy
 - Registration of programs with minors
 - Contracts with external organizers
 - Insurance and indemnification to cover sexual misconduct
 - Criminal background checks
 - Signed participation agreements from parents
 - Training of adults

Firearms at Events

- University follows state law
- No weapons on school property
 - Exception: Concealed weapons by permit holders
 - No open carry
